The Regina Jazz Society has staged an average of 13 live jazz performances each season during the 1999 through 2008 performance seasons. Performances are normally held at either Le Bistro or the Regina Inn, with special performances held at the Casino Regina venue. The Regina Jazz Society commemorated the Saskatchewan Centennial in 2005 by publishing "The Jazz Province: The Story of Jazz in Saskatchewan" written by Ken Mitchell and by hosting the concert "The Jazz Province: A Celebration in Music" highlighting the history of jazz in our province featuring renowned jazz artists from Saskatchewan including P J Perry, Gord Foote, Jon Ballantyne, Tilden Webb, Ted Warren, Trent Reschny, Andrea Menard, Pat Steel and Jack Semple. JazzFest Regina 2009 is the first annual summer jazz festival presented by the Regina Jazz Society.
